THIRD, take a bigger look at our state, our country and the world. Are there bad things happening? Do they need God's power in those places? Write down what you want to pray about on the card that says "MY WORLD."

Now let's talk to God!

Take each card and let God know what's happening, and why the people, places or situations on each card need God's help. Let Him know what's on your heart. God hears your prayers! His power changes things!
