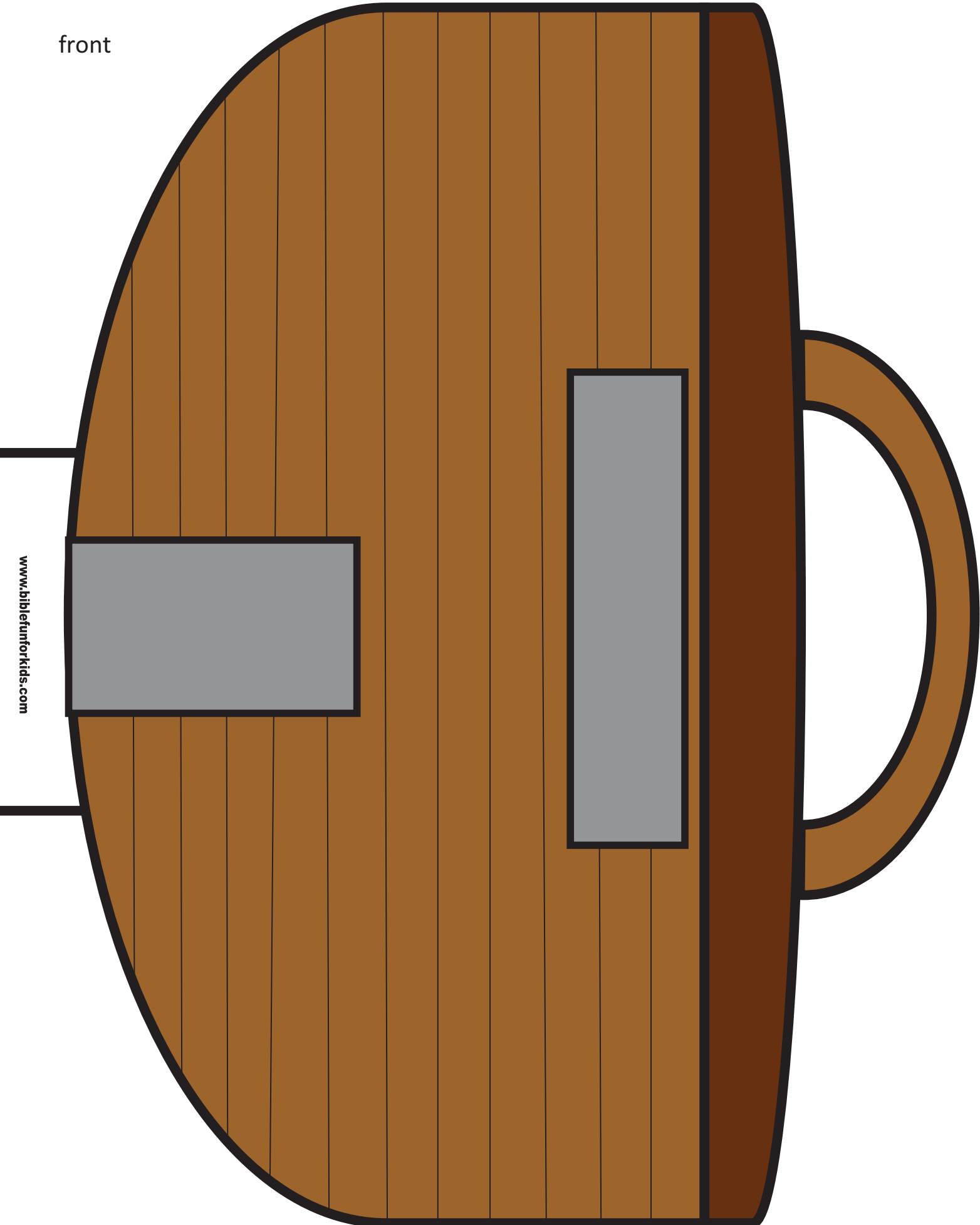


The animals can be glued to the inside, or students can use them to Play-It-Out!

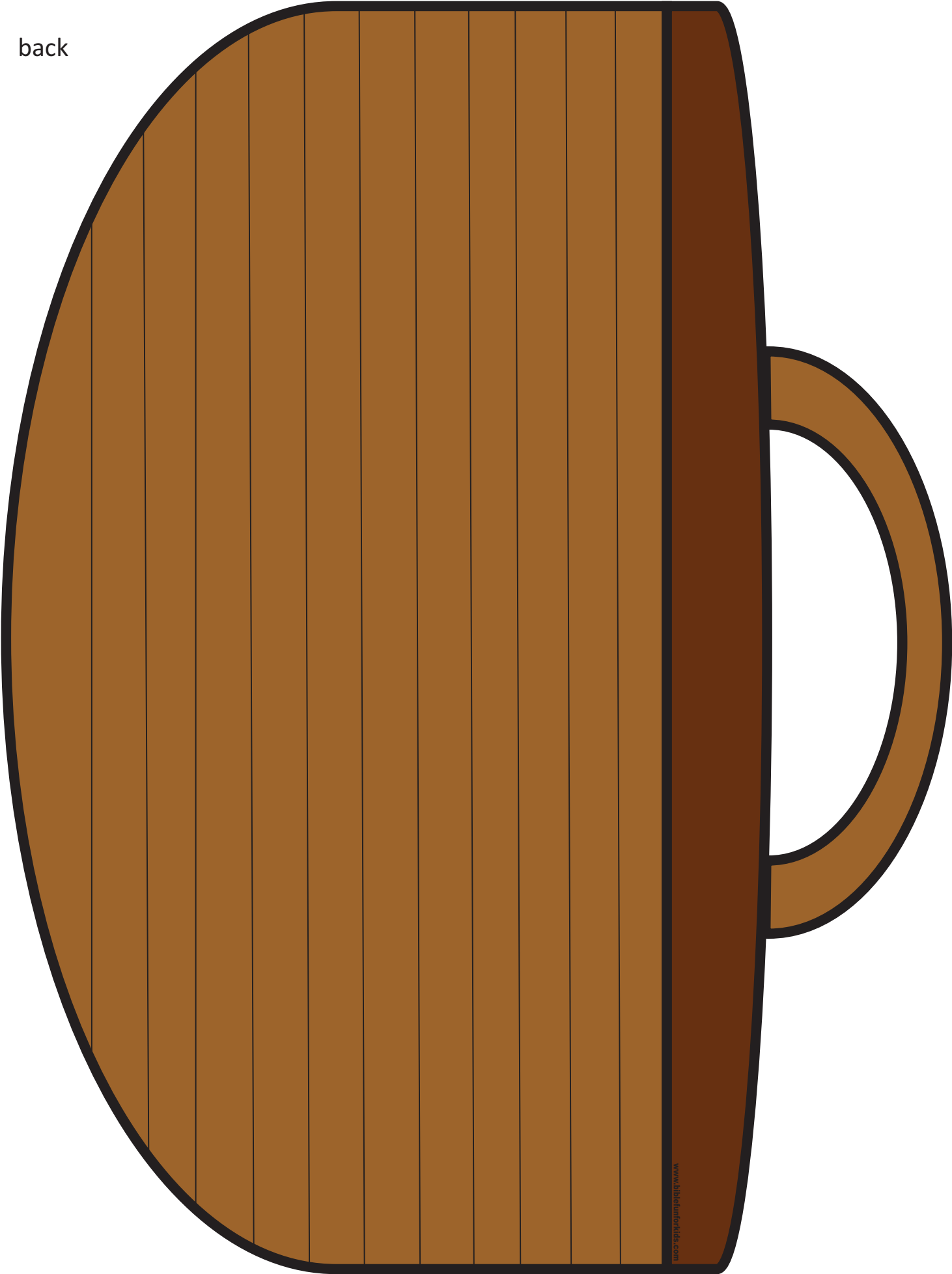

Directions

Print both sides of the ark on brown cardstock. Cut out ark and fold tab along the bottom of ark. Glue the tab to the inside of the back of the ark along the bottom. Also, cut out center of the carry handle. Cut the animal squares apart after printing on white paper or cardstock. Students can open the ark and glue the animals inside, or they can use it as a play it out and let the animals 'walk' to the ark and stay inside. You can add an envelope inside for storage if you prefer not to glue the animals. The front of the ark has one door and one window. The students can close the animals in the ark and carry them like a suitcase.
