NOTES FOR FAMILY OR GROUP STUDY

1. What are you thankful for? What challenge or stress are you facing?
(Consider praying about these together.)
2. Consider looking at one or some of these verses together on "**DISCOVERING PEACE IN TURMOIL: RESTING IN GOD.**" Read the passage together (at least twice), and take turns retelling in your own words as if sharing with a friend who isn't here. What stands out to you and why?
3. What do these verses tell us about God? What do these verses tell us about humanity/about us?
4. If this is God speaking, how will you apply it to your life? (Aim for a specific: "**I will...**" step of obedience.)
5. Who will you share with before we meet again? (Name a specific person you want to **share with.**)
