DISCOVERY QUESTIONSFOR FAMILY OR GROUP DISCUSSION

- 2. Read Psalm 46 together (at least twice), and take turns retelling it in your own words as if sharing with a friend who isn't here.

- If this is God speaking, how will you apply it to your life? (Aim for a specific: "I will..." next step.)
- 5. Who will you share with before we meet again? (Name a specific person you want to **share with**.)
