Case Study, Ethnos360

1 KEEPING IT REAL

Which is more intimidating: sharing the gospel with people you know here, or sharing it with strangers somewhere else? Why?

2 LOOK AT THE BOOK

Read John 4:39-42 and John 9:24-33. How did these two people share their faith? What was the basis of that sharing? What was the response? What has Jesus done in your life that you could share?

3 Consider what Paul says about his experience sharing the gospel in 1 Corinthians 2:1-5 and 3:5-6. What was the focus of and power behind his testimony? What gave him the confidence to share what he knew? Who is responsible for the results?

4 THE NEXT STEP

What help, preparation or encouragement do you need to do your part in taking the gospel to your family, friends, neighbors and coworkers? How will you pray about this?

NEXT STEPS

- Memorize: Proverbs 11:30.
- Study Proverbs chapter 8. Consider what truths about God to study further.
- Pray God will help you better understand how God's Wisdom would benefit the worldview of someone you know.
- Contact a foreign missionary. Encourage them for exercising true wisdom and commit to stand with them!
