- John wrote 1 John so that those who believe in the name of the Son of God may Know that they have eternal life.
- 2. Abel's <u>death</u> wasn't the main point of his appearance in Scripture; his *faith* was.
- 3. To determine the state of our heart, we should ask, "Is obeying God's **commands** a **burden** to me?"
- 4. 1 John 2:8 says that the darkness is already <u>Passing</u> away.
- 5. God gives Christians new hearts so that they <u>Want</u> to know Him better and <u>Want</u> to obey Him.
- 6. If you're not sure about whether you are saved, look at how your life is **changing** over time. Change shows your true desires.
- 7. Don't ask, "Am really worthy?" or "Did really do enough? We need to be asking, "Is <u>Jesus</u> really worthy?" and "Did <u>Jesus</u> really do enough?"

8. The more we <u>look</u> to <u>Jesus</u> and away from ourselves, the more we will find restful, sweet <u>assurance</u>!
