## NOTES FOR PERSONAL & SMALL GROUP STUDY

### KEEPING IT REAL

**1** Jesus said we **are** the salt of the earth and the light of the world (Matthew 5:13-14). What does His assertion mean in the context of grace (vs. works)?

### LOOK AT THE BOOK

**2** We know today that salt is a very stable chemical compound. When Jesus talked about salt losing its flavor (Matthew 5:13), what did He mean?

**3** In Romans 10:4, Paul says Christ is the "end of the law" to those who believe. Relate Paul's statement to Jesus' saying in Matthew 5:18 that "not the smallest letter or stroke shall pass from the Law until all is accomplished."

### TAKING IT FURTHER

**4** Jesus said to do our good works in such a way that those who see them will glorify our Father in Heaven (Matthew 5:16). How can you do your good works to accomplish this?
