Matthew 6:1-18, p. 678

Please understand these foundational truths:

- \rightarrow God wants me to live a godly life (5:1-48).
- \rightarrow My godliness is to be very practical (6:1-18).
- \rightarrow God looks in the secret places of my life (6:4, 6, 18).
- → Why is more important than what (6:2, 5, 16).
- \rightarrow God wants to reward me (6:1, 4, 6, 18).

As Christ followers, we give, we pray, we forgive, we commit ourselves to God.

Watch out for these traps:

THE

- I do not believe *hypocrisy is a problem* for me (6:1). 1.
- I desire the *applause* of others rather than the *approval* of God 2. (6:2-6, 16).
- I prefer **short-term** rather than **long-term** rewards (6:2-5, 16). 3.
- I am manipulative rather than humble when I pray (6:5-13).
- I hoard rather than *extend* grace (6:14-15).
- I want others, rather than only God, to notice my **Sacrifice** (6:16-18) 6.

ONE THING: The chase increases the enticement of the traps!

How do you see Jesus (God) chasing after us in these verses? In what way could unforgiveness hold you in bondage? What did Jesus say a consequence of our not forgiving others would be?

TAKING IT FURTHER

These areas (alms, prayer, forgiveness and fasting) are examples of Jesus wanting us to be sincere (honest, truthful), not phony or self-righteous. Do an honest evaluation of your inner life. In the power of the Holy Spirit, what changes will you make?
