The Joy of Generosity Roger Ellis, Lead Pastor 2 Corinthians 9:7, p. 807

"Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a *cheerful* giver."

2 Corinthians 9:7 NIV

How do I know if I am a cheerful giver? What does it looks like?

- My generosity is an expression of <u>my belief</u> in the mission. (Luke 8:1-3)
- My generosity is motivated by <u>my compassion</u> for others. (Luke 10:33-35)

- My generosity is my declaration of what I believe to be <u>most</u> important in life. (Luke 12:15-21)
- 4. My lack of generosity reveals that *my faith is phony*. (Luke 18:22-23)
- 5. My generosity springs from **a heart of gratitude**. (Luke 19:8-9)

(2 Corinthians 8:9; Isaiah 53:10; Hebrews 12:2; 2 Corinthians 9:15)
