Who the Lord is, is Enough

Roger Ellis, Lead Pastor Psalm 23, p.382

How can I find contentment in the midst of the turmoil of each day?

- Admit that on my own <u>I will never be content</u> (Psalm 23:1).
- Identify my shepherd (Psalm 23:1).
- <u>Trust</u> my shepherd (Psalm 23:2-6).

Is my shepherd trustworthy? A trustworthy shepherd is:

- 1. One who is always with me.
- One who calms my fears so I can <u>settle down</u> in times of green and brown (Psalm 23:2).
- 3. One who leads me with **honor** (Psalm 23:3).
- One who gives me the courage to <u>walk through treacherous</u> <u>valleys</u> (Psalm 23:4).
- 5. One who will protect me (Psalm 23:4).
- 6. One who is a *generous host* (Psalm 23:5).
- 7. One who **chases** after me (Psalm 23:6).
- 8. One who assures me that evil will not *have the final word* (Psalm 23:6).

THEONE THING: The Lord is enough.

LOOK AT THE BOOK

- Consider Eve (Genesis 3:1-9) and Job (Job 1:13-22, 19:25-27). What is the relationship between contentment with God and our circumstances? What was the root cause of Eve's discontent and Job's contentment?
- One way that we know God is by knowing what He has done. What has God already done for us? (Genesis 1:26 and 2:7; Psalm 19:1-4 and 19:7-9; John 3:16 and 14:1-3; Ephesians 2:8-10; Philippians 2:6-10 and Hebrews 1:1-3; or any other Scriptures).
