Life is full of obstacles that challenge our faith in Christ. We need to recognize what happens in the midst of this opposition and embrace two simple convictions.

- 1. The gospel advances in the face of opposition (1:12-14).
- 2. The gospel advances in the face of *rivalry* (1:15-18).
- 3. The gospel advances in the face of life and death (1:19-30).
- 4. The challenge: Live life based upon two simple convictions:
 - a. BE CONVINCED \rightarrow **To live is Christ**
 - b. BE CONVINCED → to die is gain

How will your conduct be the same or different this week as a result of your decision? How will you be transformed by the renewing of your mind?
