The Prophet Obadiah Roger Ellis, Lead Pastor Obadiah, p. 357

Remember: The importance and power of the prophetic message has nothing to do with the size of the book or the reputation of the prophet. It has to do with the clear and accurate proclamation of the Word of God.

The back story: Enter Jacob & Esau (Genesis 25-33)

Principles for today:

- 1. Greatness is no guarantee against the judgment of God (Obadiah 2-4).
- 2. God keeps His promises.
- 3. Ultimately, God will **deliver justice** (Obadiah 15).
- 4. Ultimately, God will have the *final say* (Obadiah 18).
- 5. Ultimately, the Kingdom *Will belong* to God (Obadiah 21).
